Additionally, I am saving for my son's education, as I do not want him to have large amounts of college debt as I did.

While the monies offered through LHAAMC greatly reduce my out-of-pocket expense for school, it does not cover the cost for tuition if I follow my recommended course plan. I would greatly like to stay on track for completion of my degree.
