Thanks to the extraordinary generosity of Sally and her late husband, Raymond, our hospital will be better equipped to meet the growing needs of our community. Their leadership gift not only addresses urgent priorities but also inspires others to join in making a difference, multiplying its impact for years to come.

"My philosophy is to be grateful for what I have and share my resources with the community," said Sally. "I have an extensive volunteer history wherever I have lived, and this volunteerism has led to being a donor to several institutions in the Annapolis area. I have been an Annapolis resident for 23 years and feel a strong tie to the community."

Sally recognizes that LHAAMC is the hospital for countless families in our county. Since 2011, the county's population has grown by more than 10 percent, and the number of patients seen at LHAAMC has risen by 20 percent, creating urgent challenges as we work to meet demand while upholding our standards of exceptional care. Our Emergency Department (ED) alone sees more than 100,000 patients each year, making it the busiest in Maryland and among the top 40 in the nation. Full inpatient units lead to crowded ED hallways and long wait times, straining staff and patients alike.

Recognizing that maintaining excellence requires decisive action, Sally's gift serves as the lead contribution to a major philanthropic initiative supporting Luminis Health's Vision 2030 strategic plan. This investment will help expand patient care space, introduce innovative, patient-centered solutions, and ensure LHAAMC can continue to serve our growing community with excellence.
