2,000 SURVIVORS — Received counseling, navigation, and wellness resources through the Cancer Survivorship Program at the Geaton and JoAnn DeCesaris Cancer Institute, thanks to supporters of Fish For A Cure (F4AC). The 2025 F4AC Tournament, Paul C. Dettor Captain's Challenge, and Shore Party raised a record-breaking \$1.2 million.

3 MAJOR MILESTONES — Reflected decades of trusted care for mothers, babies, and families. The Rebecca M. Clatanoff Pavilion marked 30 years of new beginnings, Teddy's Place, LHAAMC's Level III NICU, reached 20 years of caring for more than 500 vulnerable newborns each year, and The Tom and Nancy Frank Family Birth Center celebrated 10 years of family-centered birth experiences.

50,000 HOURS — Were given by more than 550 volunteers across LHAAMC. Their time, compassion, and steady presence brought comfort and connection to patients, families, and team members every day.

500 PATIENTS — Received compassionate, timely care through Maryland's first geriatric Emergency Department (ED) teleconsult program at LHAAMC. Quick specialist support in our ED reduced hospital stays by 35 percent, helping older adults heal safely at home.

12,000 BADGE SWIPES — Have found a quiet, restorative space in our Employee Wellbeing Lounge, made possible through donor generosity. This dedicated room helps caregivers regroup and renew their energy during their most challenging days.

750 HEARTS — Have been repaired since LHAAMC launched its cardiac surgery program, which now includes innovative approaches like cryo nerve block therapy to help eliminate pain and improve outcomes.

87 RESIDENTS — Are currently training at LHAAMC, helping prepare the next generation of physicians who will care for our community close to home.

2,000 CHILDREN AND TEENS — Receive pediatric mental health care at LHAAMC each year, and supporters of Denim & Diamonds help ensure these young patients experience compassionate support during their hardest moments. The 2025 Denim & Diamonds Bash raised \$1 million to strengthen pediatric mental health services at LHAAMC.

26 NURSES — Were supported through nursing scholarships you helped fund. Your generosity allowed new nurses to begin their journey and experienced caregivers to advance their training, strengthening compassionate care across our community.

\$84.7 MILLION — Was provided in community benefit by LHAAMC in 2025, funding charity care, subsidized programs, outreach, education, and research that support the health of our region.

- LHAAMC received multiple American Heart Association awards for excellence in STEMI, coronary artery disease, and stroke care.
- Healthgrades named LHAAMC among the best hospitals in the nation for orthopedic surgery and joint replacement, and Becker's recognized Luminis Health as one of the top 100 orthopedic programs.
- LHAAMC's respiratory care program received the Apex Recognition Award from the American Association for Respiratory Care for meeting the highest national standards.
